TYC IS OPEN!


Finally, the first page news that we have all been waiting for, we're back, we're open, and we're better than ever!




A Day at the Fairgrounds Racetrack



HELLO FROM THE TONIZZO's

Luis and Jeanne Tonizzo sent us this update on their lives since Katrina, here is their story in Jeanne's words:

Well here we are up in the snowy northeast, actually in Down East Maine. Cooper is a little town, which basically consists of a huge beautiful lake, hills and mountains, and a small county store. Aside from that there are some homes dotted into the thick Maine woods, some homes on the lake, and blueberry fields, bears, eagles, moose . . .

Canada is about 25 minutes away . . . the border city of Calais is on the St. Croix River, which is tidal and runs into Passamaquaddy Bay. We go to church in Eastport, the most eastern town in the United States. Eastport has breathtaking ocean views and the Passamaquaddy Indian Reservation.

Our home was originally built in 1857, and was a one-room schoolhouse and Grange Hall. School downstairs, Grange upstairs. It will be some work, but when renovated it will be great. It has all the original features and a lot of character (ask Luis and he will say that translates into a lot of work . . . yup!). We heat the house with wood, which Luis split from trees we got from a friend who is a lumberjack. He is an officer of the Cathance Grange of which we are members. The Grange is a very old and time-honored society of farmers and landowners and we meet in a building which is a historic Grange Hall dating and constructed about the same time and in the same fashion as out house. A lot of the present officers of the grange went to school in our house. The last year of school in this building was around 1965.

We have six dogs and a cat, all evacuated with me and Mother in a Jeep Cherokee. (Luis was at sea at the time.) That was a trip to remember. But we made it to New Jersey and eventually to Maine.

As this was a Christmas note, they closed with wishing everyone a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.




