RACING NEWS

Wednesday Night Racing is back and the competition is tight. The annual Bill Watson Spring Series I is halfway through with 4 boats in the Spinnaker Class all within reach of the first place spot. Currently Weather Witch leads with 8 points followed by Kokopelli with 9. In third place is Phoenix with 10.5 points and a half a point back in fourth is Good Groceries with 11. In the Non Spinnaker Class Bali Hai is in first place with three bullets. In second place is Rcondo with Relax in third. So far we have had eleven boats participate in the first series with a few others out there enjoying the nice spring weather. Our committee boats have been a combination of effort from several volunteers. The Coast Guard Auxiliary with help from Martin Smith provided their vessel on one of the races and Gary Knight on his vessel "Christy Lee" volunteered to provide the starting line and signals for the other two. Wayne Russ has also been out there on his power boat helping to set the pin and upwind marks. The first series has been a tune up with a triangle course consisting of an up wind mark set for the first leg and the Tammany mark used as the wing mark. There is plenty of opportunity for anyone that wants to learn this exciting sport and Wednesday night racing is where it all begins. If anyone would like to participate in either the racing activities or can offer their time to help with race committee, please get in touch with me. We meet on the pier behind the club around 5:30 and usually shove off between 6:00 and 6:15. The racing starts at 7:00 and, depending on the wind conditions, everyone is back at the club around 8:30 or 9:00.

In other racing news, last weekend was the Gulf Offshore Racing Circuit and Mark Palermo and the crew of his Beneteau First Forty "Sapphire" swept the five race series. He not only was undefeated in class A Spinnaker but also took first in the overall competition with a low score of 5. Congratulations go out to Mark and his entire crew for a job well done.

This Saturday, April 12th is the first Club Race of 2008. Most competitors will meet at the club around 8:30 in the morning with the race starting at 10:00 in the Play Pen. 


Membership
