


General Membership Meeting - January 16th

In February I stepped up to try and organize the 2008 Two Against the Lake regatta. The logistics of putting together this regatta were challenging for someone who hasn't had a lot of experience and I learned a lot of lessons during the course of the planning. I'm happy to report that we had 23 boats on the line which was almost double of our participation from the year before. The sailors battled against light air, at time makes less than a knot of headway on even the fastest of craft. Much thanks goes out to everyone who volunteered their time and boats.
