It should be fun.


I know there should be at least 6 of our boats available to ride on.

Basic Rules

Rule 10 - Port/Stbd - A port tack boat must stay clear of a stbd. tack boat.

Rule 11 - Windward/leeward - A windward boat must stay clear of a leeward boat.

Rule 12 – Overtaking - A boat clear astearn must stay clear of a boat ahead.

Rule 13 – Tacking - A boat that is tacking must stay clear of one that is not.

Rule 14 - Avoiding contact - A boat shall avoid contact with another boat, if at all possible.

Rules 31 & 44 – One or two turn penalty – A boat that acknowledges a foul, and at the first reasonable opportunity takes the required one or two penalty turns, is considered exonerated and can continue racing.

At the Start

When does racing begin? – All boats are racing at their preparatory signal. Usually at 4 min. prior to the starting signal. No engines are allowed, and all rules are in effect.

Barging – A windward inside boat has no rights at a starting mark and can be luffed head-to-wind.

Right to luff before the starting signal – Prior to the starting signal, a windward boat can be luffed from ahead or from astearn, but the leeward boat must give her opportunity to keep clear.

Right to luff after the starting signal – If the leeward boat aquired luffing rights from clear astearn, her luffing rights end at the starting signal and began again after starting. If she aquired luffing rights while clear ahead, she can continue luffing even after the gun.

Committing a foul prior to the start – When a boat commits a foul or hits the starting mark prior to the preparatory signal, she is not racing and no penalty turns are required. Committing a foul after the preparatory signal requires penalty turns, which can be executed prior to the starting signal.

Over early (OCS) – A boat over early has rights before returning to re-start and no rights while returning to re-start

Rounding the weather mark (Rule 18)

The zone – Rule 18 begins when the first boats hull enters a 3-boat length circle around the mark. Inside overlap & Mark Room – Inside overlaps must be established before entering the three-boat length zone. The outside boat must give the inside overlapped boat mark room.

Port/Stbd. Inside the zone – Rule 10 is in effect.

Tacking inside the zone – Rule 13 is in effect.

Rounding the leeward and downwind marks (Rule 18)

The zone, Inside overlap & Room – Rule 18 applies the same as at the weather mark except when boats are on opposite tacks.

On Opposite Tacks – Stbd. tack has the right of way, but a stbd. tack boat must give an off-wind port tack boat mark room when she has an inside overlap.

Finishing

Room to finish – Rule 18 applies with regard to inside overlaps and mark room.

Clearing the finish line – A boat is considered racing until she clears the finish line and is subject to all the rules of racing until she is clear.

Hitting the mark - A boat that hits a finishing mark must do a one tack, one gybe penalty. She must also return to the course side of the line, and then re-finish.







