TYC Juniors Update



Martin and I had two recent meetings with Warren Property management and the final answer on Wed, Jan 6th is that we have a green light to reestablish the small boat site adjacent to the club. We must comply with several other conditions: moving the storage containers to the original footprint and painting them; fencing the site on the street and northwest sides; storing the small boats and equipment in the containers and generally keeping the open area clear. We have begun work to throw out trash from the large container, fill has been dropped to do some spot grading and we will build the final floating dock section as soon as the freezing weather backs off. 
