

SCORING: The Race shall be scored using PHRF Ratings.

**PRIZES:** Prize awards are TBD and will depend upon the number of entries. We will attempt to continue the traditional prizes awarded in this event, i.e. Spinnaker Class and Non-Spinnaker Class, 1<sup>st</sup> TYC boat to finish, 1<sup>st</sup> Multi-hull to finish, 1<sup>st</sup> Husband/Wife team, 1<sup>st</sup> Parent/Child, 1<sup>st</sup> female team, and 1<sup>st</sup> team whose aggregate age exceeds 100 years.

ENTRY FEE: \$50.00. Entry fee deadline is 0930 hrs Saturday, April 10.

If you do not register on-line, please fill out and bring the registration from below to the skippers meeting. # Safety at Sea Seminar

On February 27th, four of your TYC members (Mark Palermo, Bobby Tassin, David Bolyard and Kevin Blank) attended the Safety at Sea Seminar sponsored by Pensacola Yacht Club. For the current edition of the Isla Mujeres race, the race organizers were encouraging attendance of this program, but it was not mandatory. For the next race in 2012, one third of the crew must have gone through this seminar in order to qualify for the race.

Although we were there to focus on safety while on our way to the finish line in Mexico, this was a great course that would have served any serious boater well, power or sailing. The day started off with a focus on personal buoyancy and hypothermia. They could not stress enough about the importance of wearing PFDs. They cover boat preparation, rescue techniques, damage control, maneuvers, and much more. We discussed the proper deployment of a life raft and got a little taste of how small they can be in the foyer of the club. Just before our lunch break, the Coast Guard was kind enough to perform two different demonstrations of water rescues from a helicopter right next to the club.

The lessons you walk away with from a course like this make boating more enjoyable and may someday save a life. I encourage any of our members to attend the next time it comes around.


