

From article VIII, TYC Bylaws:

"Dues, charges, or assessments are due and payable on the first day of the month in which they are billed. Any member who has not paid his/her dues, charges, or assessments when the next monthly bill is rendered shall be notified on the bill that he/she is delinquent. The member shall be notified that if the delinquency is not paid by the fifteenth (15th) of the current month, his/her name shall be posted as being delinquent. This member shall be placed on a cash only basis on the fifteenth (15th) of the month for any charges at the Club. Any member who has not paid his/her delinquency when the next monthly bill is rendered shall be notified that he/she is suspended from membership, shall have no right of access to Club facilities or functions, and shall lose GYA reciprocal privileges. This member's suspension shall be posted and he/she shall be notified in writing. Any member who is thirty (30) days delinquent shall be reported to the Board of Directors at the next Board meeting. If the member has not paid his/her delinquency by the next billing period he/she shall be automatically expelled from membership. A member who is not expelled, upon application and approval by the Commodore or Vice Commodore, may suspend his/her membership without privileges and may resume membership upon payment of any delinquencies. Dues shall be suspended during this period of suspension. The suspended member may attend the Club as a guest of any member in "good standing.""




