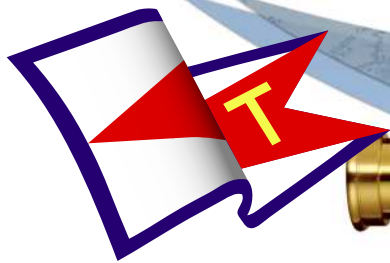

Ahoy!

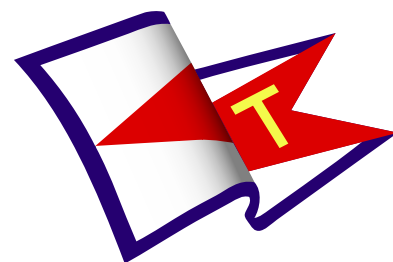

TYC Racing

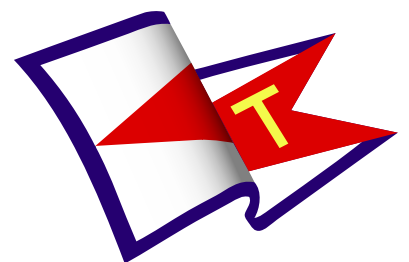

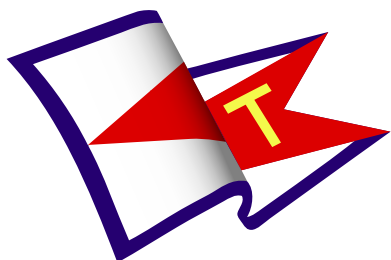


Cecile Ann Courrege
