





(Neutral Ground at Veterans Boulevard and Causeway Boulevard)

The Redfish Base Chapter of the United States Submarine Veterans is proud to announce the unveiling of the USS Golet (SS-361) Submariner Memorial to take place at Veterans Memorial Square in Metairie, March 9, 2013, at 11:00am.

A total of 3,505 American submariners made the ultimate sacrifice in the defense of their country in World War II. Fifty-two United States submarines were lost during WWII. The United States submarine service suffered the highest mortality rate of all branches of the U.S. Military during WWII. The Submarine Veterans of WWII assigned each of the 52 lost submarines to a state for the purpose of establishing memorials to the dedication of the men and boats now on eternal patrol. The USS Golet (SS-361) was assigned to the State of Louisiana..

After a lengthy search for the proper and fitting home to display the monument, it was determined Veterans Memorial Square on Veterans Boulevard in Metairie would be the best site to afford the monument recognition and appreciation as tribute to our nation's Submarine Veterans. Coast Guard

The Coast Guard Auxiliary invites you to bring your boat to them and they'll conduct a safety inspection involving personal flotation devices, fire extinguishers, flares, and other required safety equipment.

If you pass inspection, they will apply a sticker to the port side of your boat. Subsequently, if you are stopped on the water by the Coast Guard for an official inspection and they see the sticker that indicates you recently passed, they're quite likely to not go through their own inspection (although they could).


