
VETERANS DAY



The 2019 Bill Watson Memorial Fall Wednite Series is in the books. Please join me in hereby and when you see them in personally thanking our sponsor, **Kevin Jordan and Bodega in Bay St Louis**. It can't happen without Mike and Melinda Parks and Dodie Jones being the on the water race committee, so remember to thank them as well all the folks who helped set marks and shuttle RC equipment. We finished the fall series with all three new T, Y and C marks on station. Mike Parks contributed an innovative upgrade to our ground tackle which includes a terminal stainless-steel chain segment including a sub-surface buoy where it connects to the regular chain. This should serve to keep the chain off the bottom, thereby reducing abrasive wear and tear and prolonging the life of the whole rig. The Wednite series had some close competition in the Spinnaker fleet which Crazy Diamond won with a very solid performance. Non-Spinnaker was swept by Nightshift with all bullets! For full results:

The Single-Handed Race was October 5th. Sadly, it was in doubt with no one signing up until the last few days prior and we ended up with a fleet of four competitors. Conditions were nice but light air dictated a shorter course, 15.08 miles and triangular in configuration. Kyle on Seduisant had a dominating win of over 30 minutes on corrected time. The other finishes were Sandy on Nightshift, Ryan Finn on Jzerro and Austin Abel on Francis – all within about 3 minutes of each other on corrected time. We need to work together to promote the SHR in years to come, both here and around the lake. In past years we would have the soup night or chili cook-off on the evening of the race and that type of coordinated food event does enhance it!



The LPRC was held (hostage by the weather) on October 25 – 27th. We had 34 boats registered and the worst weather that anyone could recall – a rainout on day one and not enough wind on day three to run any races. Thus, the entire regatta boiled down to a single race which was the distance race on Saturday from NOYC to PYC. Basically, a nightmare scenario for the race committee. But kudos to PYC as Tropical Storm Olga ripped up Mandeville early Saturday AM and despite no power, they hosted the fleet on Saturday and Sunday with aplomb. Tammany had three boats and many crews from TYC in the regatta. Crazy Diamond in Spinnaker A and Seduisant in Racer/Cruiser both got a 4th and StraitJacket in Spinnaker B got a 2nd (and some seafood in a deep spinnaker “shrimping” snafu). Full results:







Membership News

These are “Rules” as agreed by the board 10 September 2019.

There are six types of individuals that enter TYC:

1. A robber or an arsonist—Call the police
