



**Wednesday Night Racing** is starting up in less than two weeks with the first race taking place on March 11th. For twelve consecutive weeks we will meet at Tammany Yacht Club and head out to participate in a friendly competition. After each race, everyone heads back to the club for burgers and beer. It is open to all so if you know of anyone who may be interested, invite them up to the club and we will find them a boat to hop on. The skippers meeting will take place this Wednesday night, March 4th with free draft beer from 6:30 to 8:00. We will discuss the logistics of the series and answer any questions one might have. If you are interested in getting out on the water, but not necessarily wanting to race, there is usually room on one of the spectator boats. In addition, our race committee can always use extra hands to help and is another great way to participate.

March 21st is our annual Two Against the Lake Race where each boat is limited to just that, a crew of two. The course is usually about 30 miles long taking the fleet in a triangle around the lake. The start is just downwind of Channel Marker 2 at the entrance to Bayou Liberty. From there the boats will beat upwind and round the mark on their way to a tetrahedron on the south shore. It's then west to the Causeway and finally back to Bayou Liberty. Depending on the weather conditions the race usually takes around 5 or 6 hours to complete. There are both spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes. There are special categories for the diverse makeup of crew depending on participation. Best TYC Boat, Parent-Child, Male-Female, and Century Awards were all presented in years past. A skippers meeting will be held at the TYC the night before starting at 7:30. All participants will receive the traditional Two Against the Lake t-shirt so signing up early will help us to get an accurate count of the number needed. Let's keep this tradition alive by getting plenty of boats out on the water.

If you have any questions about these events or sailing in general, please do not hesitate to ask either me or Dr. Bobby and one of us will gladly help you with the answers.
